HOUSING FORM

Housing at the AUCP is in carefully selected French homes on a demi-pension basis. Students are provided with a room of their own, sheets, and towels. Breakfast seven days a week and five evening meals a week are eaten in the home. As in the U.S., families have varying profiles. Some hosts may be traditional families (mother, father, children, pets) while others may be young couples, retirees, single parents, etc.

A homestay of several months allows students a unique cultural experience living with and like the French. Living as a guest in their host's home, students are naturally expected to abide by household rules and to act responsibly and courteously as such situations demand.

All housing arrangements and changes are made with the consent of the AUCP. Please respond carefully to the questions which follow. The answers will help us choose housing that is most appropriate for you.
